Day 1

Day 5

Alvados 🖨 Coimbra 🖨 Viseu

Day 6

Later, we'll turn our attention to Pinhão –where a cruise in a traditional rabelo boat awaits. Bask in the cinematic scenery of the Douro Valley as we enjoy a leisurely ride to Peso da Régua. And tonight? There's another sumptuous dinner in store at our hotel.

Day 7
