In Vienna, explore grand imperial palaces such as Schönbrunn and Hofburg, and enjoy a classical music performance at one of the city's renowned concert halls. Afterwards, make a quick stop in Bratislava, Slovakia's capital, where medieval and modern blend effortlessly, before concluding your trip in Budapest. Here, soak in the thermal baths, marvel at the majestic Parliament Building, and enjoy views of the Danube from Buda Castle or Fisherman's Bastion, rounding out your Central European adventure.

Day 1

Berlin

Greetings from Berlin! This beautiful metropolis is the capital city of Germany, and is considered to be one of the greenest in Europe. As you arrive, join the welcome meeting at the hotel lobby at 6:00pm. Later on, you can get to know your fellow travellers in the optional group dinner. You can then immerse yourself in the lively nocturnal atmosphere of Berlin at your own pace.

Day 2

Berlin

Start your adventure in Central Europe with a guided tour of Berlin, beginning with a visit to the historic Reichstag building, which has housed the German Parliament since its construction in 1894. Day 3

Although significant portions of this city fell victim to wartime destruction, meticulous restoration efforts have restored its former splendour, notably showcased in landmarks such as the Royal Palace and its museum housing treasures dating back to the 1720s. Your guided walking tour will lead you to iconic sites such as the Zwinger Palace, the Semper Opera, and the unmistakable Dresden Frauenkirche, the Church of Our Lady, meticulously reconstructed from rubble. As the day comes to a close, we travel on to Prague and check in to your hotel. You can join the optional Medieval Dinner Show in an actual cave for a unique experience in the Czech Republic.

Day 4

Prague
